General Rules for Participants:

1. The participant must be a regular student of a college/Institution.
2. All undergraduate and postgraduate students are eligible to participate in the events only on the presentation of their ID.
3. All registrations are based on first come first serve basis
4. The participants shall carry their identification card or a letter from the College/Institution they are representing.
5. The participants must present the identity card whenever they are required to do so by our institute representatives.
6. The students can participate in any number of events from the college/Institute .The Students must see the event schedule before selecting the events to avoid participating in the events taking place simultaneously.
7. There shall be a registration fee of Rs.100 per person per event to be paid by cash by 24th October 2017 before 1100 hrs. (For Group events, participants shall pay the fee on individual basis). Outstation students can register before 24th October before 11 hrs and pay the fee on 25th morning.
8. Out station students can avail the accommodation facility for a fee of Rs. 200. This fee includes the 1 night-stay with breakfast, lunch and dinner for 1 day.
9. Students availing this facility will bring their own toiletries and other accessories.
10. The accommodation shall be provided on first come first basis only. Students need to confirm their accommodation requirement before 23rd October 2017.
11. It shall be the responsibility of the outstation student to reach the institute on time.
12. The registration of the events can be done online on our website www.nithm.ac.in. Incomplete entries will not be considered for registration. There is no spot registration.
13. The judges decision regarding the competition shall be final and binding.
14. Reporting time for the participants is 9:15 AM.

Competition No: 2 Rang de Rangoli

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Open to all categories, UG & PG students with a valid College Identity card.

Rules

1. The Size of Rangoli should not exceed size of is 4*4 ft.
2. A group of 2 students can participate as team. The Students will bring own material for Rangoli.
3. Flowers / grass / edible / natural materials/rice/ colors is to be used. No paints or color powder are allowed.
4. Participants should bring their own Rangoli material.
5. The maximum time limit is 1 ½ hours. No electrical / electronic help is allowed.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Open to all categories, UG & PG students with a valid College Identity card.

Rules

1. It is an individual event.
2. Competition is open for both students of various Degree and PG College.

4. The photography in the entirety must be a single work of original material taken by the participant.

10. The images will be selected by a panel of judges and their decision is final. No correspondence pertaining to the selection process and decision will be entertained.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

RULES

1. The maximum size of the team is limited to 2 persons for each team.

“Promotion of Hyderabad as a Tourism Destination”.

All graphics should be designed for a single-sided, centered screen-printed placement. All submissions must be in vector PDF, Adobe Illustrator or .EPS format, to the email id given below.

ARTIST MUST ACKNOWLEDGE THAT EACH ENTRY DESIGN IS:

- a) wholly original;
- b) does not incorporate or include any material that would require the consent of any third party;
- c) does not violate any copyright, trademark, publicity right, privacy right, or any other right of any third party.

NITHM shall have the right to edit, composite, scan, duplicate or alter the entry design for any purpose which it deems necessary or desirable, without the need for any further compensation, and/or permission. Submissions including offensive language, imagery or themes will be excluded from competition.

WINNER SELECTION:

All entries will be judged by a panel of judges comprised of creative professionals based on the following criteria:

- a) Originality (25%),
- b) Creativity of activity (25%)
- c) Practicality (25%)
- d) Appropriateness to Theme of “**Promotion of Hyderabad as a Tourism Destination**” (25%).

Competition No: 8 – Debate

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Open to all categories, UG & PG students with a valid College Identity card.

1. Students will be divided into two groups each with one student
2. Each group will divided itself into two teams with one member each: one team will support the proposition (the affirmative team). The other team will oppose the proposition(the negative team)
3. When one member is debating the other member will act as judge.
4. First a member of the affirmative team will speak for two minutes after which he or she will be cross examined by the member of the negative team.(one question - 2 minutes)
5. Next a member of the negative team will speak for two minutes after which he or she will be cross examined by the member of the affirmative team.(one question- 2 minutes)
6. A rebuttal will then take place, first by member of the affirmative team talking for two minutes and then by the member of the negative team talking for two minutes (4 minutes)
7. The audience will then have 5 minutes to ask questions to both teams(5 minutes)
8. Following that the member of each team will have two minutes to make a closing statement, first from the affirmative team followed by the negative team
9. The audience will then vote to determine which team won the debate
